Travel to Malmö

Malmö is situated on the south west edge of Sweden and very convenient to reach, no matter how you chose to travel.

By train there are numerous arrivals every day from Copenhagen (25 min), from Stockholm (4h 30 min) and from Hamburg (5h 30 min).

By flight you go to Copenhagen International Airport (CPH) from every major airport in Europe and some intercontinental. Some international flights also fly to Malmö Airport (MMX). Both airports located only 20-30 min from Malmö.

By bus or car. Malmö is situated on E6, E20 and E22 close to E4 as well. If you arrive from the south west, your are going by the bridge from Copenhagen to Malmö.

Malmö Youth Games recommend you to think about our environment when planning your travel.

Fee

The entry fee for Malmö Youth Games is 900 SEK per team.

For the participants you choose Green, Blue or Orange Card. All cards includes tournament participation, transports during the games, admission to the concert, the Opening Ceremony and entrance to the "Ribban Beach" entertainment centre, the Relay and the Picnic. The Green and Blue cards also includes school accommodation and various number of meals.

Competition

All teams are guaranteed at least 8 games from Monday to Saturday. Every team will play at least one game at the giant tent at the "Ribban Beach" festival centre.

Sports – and more ...

The competition is, of course, the main issue of Malmö Youth Games. When so many young athletes gather during some nice summer days, we are also offering a week with music, entertainment, meeting places, an environmental profiled event and lots of fun also outside the sport court.
