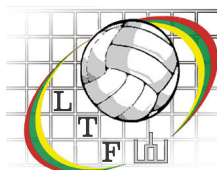

## **1st Baltic Youth Volleyball Championship for Sport schools/Clubs. REGULATIONS**

### **1. Goals**

Popularize volleyball among youth and improve young volleyball player's skills  
Determine the best Sport school/Club volleyball teams in the Baltic States for youth born in 1991.

To ensure friendly relations between youth teams in the Baltic States.

1.3. Give Sport school/Club teams International experience.

### **2. Competition organizers**

2.1. The competition is managed by the Latvian Volleyball Federation and its youth coordinator Sandra Budkēviča (t. +371 26188150, fax 7334359, [lvf@volejbols.lv](mailto:lvf@volejbols.lv), Rīga, Grostonas St 6b, LV-1012

The girls competition will be organized by the Latvian Volleyball Federation and the boys competition by the Estonian Volleyball Federation

### **3. Place and Time**

3.1. Competition takes place:

- 4-6 April Estonia, Parnu – Boys.
- 11-13 April Latvia, Kuldīga – Girls.

### **4. Participants**

4.1. Participants will be the four best sport school/club teams from Latvia, Lithuania and Estonia.

4.2. Girls – born in 1991 and younger.

4.2. Boys – born 1991 and younger

4.3. Participating players must be registered with the sport school or club by the Latvian, Lithuanian or Estonian Volleyball Federation.

4.4. Teams cannot be supplemented by players from other schools or clubs.

4.5. Delegations consist of 12 players, 1 coach, 2 team officials, **and a game referee.**  
**(National category, 1 category).**

## 5. Applications

5.1. Preliminary applications for boys teams (attachment Nr.1), which can include up to 16 players, must be sent to the [Latvian Volleyball Federation by March 21, 2008](#), girls applications by [March 31, 2008](#).

5.2. [Team final application CH –05 in his form \(12 players\) team representatives submit to the secretariat at the games venue.](#)

**5.3. The Federation's Secretary General's signature guarantees that the player is licensed to the respective sport school or club.**

## 6. Financial conditions.

6.1 Competition organizational expenses (gym rent and awards) for the girl's competition will be paid by the Latvian Volleyball Federation and the boy's tournament by the Estonian Volleyball Federation.

6.2. Expenses related to participation in the tournament (travel, lodging, meals) are paid by the delegating federation.

**6.3. Federations cover expenses for their referees (travel, meals, lodging).**

## 7. Rules.

7.1. The games will be played according to FIVB International Volleyball rules. There will be no technical timeouts.

7.2. Official game ball - Mikasa

7.3.. Games are best of five sets.

7.4. Teams receive:

- For a win – 2 points
- For a loss – 1 point
- For not arriving – 0 points.(0:25;0:25; 0:25)

7.5. If teams are tied in points the following tiebreakers are used:

- Sets won-lost in all games
- Points won-lost in all games.
- Head to head scores.

7.6. Net height:

- Girls – 2.24
- Boys – 2.43

## 8. System of play.

8.1. Based on the ratings submitted by the federations (1-4 places), teams will be split into three round robin groups of 4 teams each. (Group A,B,C)

8.2.1<sup>st</sup> Place teams (based on federation ratings) are split into separate groups. 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place teams are drawn by lot into the groups.

1. Teams play in groups single round robin – 3 games per each team (18)games

2. After games in groups teams will play Play-off's crossed semifinals and games for certain places on three (3) level in follows:



### **8.3. Preliminary play.**

8.4.. Groups play round robin.

8.5.. After the round robin:

- 1<sup>st</sup> place teams form **A** group and play semi finals.
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> place team with the best coefficient (points, all sets won-lost, all points won-lost) goes to **A** group and plays semi finals.
- The other two 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams and two 3<sup>rd</sup> place team with the best coefficient form **B** group.
- The remaining 3<sup>rd</sup> place team and the 4<sup>th</sup> place teams form **C** group.

8.6. **Level I** - Places **1.-4.** – (4 games)

First Place in Group A versus First Place in Group C

First Place in Group B versus best Second Place

For 3<sup>rd</sup> Place – Loser versus Loser

For I Place – Winner versus Winner

8.7. **Level II** – Places **5.-8.** – (4 games)

Second 2<sup>nd</sup> Place in Groups versus second 3<sup>rd</sup> Place in Groups

Third 2<sup>nd</sup> Place in Groups versus best 3<sup>rd</sup> Place in Groups

For 7<sup>th</sup> Place – Loser versus Loser

For 5<sup>th</sup> Place – Winner versus Winner

8.8. **Level III** – Places **9.-12.** – (4 games )

Third 3<sup>rd</sup> Place in Groups versus third 4<sup>th</sup> Place in Groups

First 4<sup>th</sup> Place in Groups versus second 4<sup>th</sup> Place in Groups

For 11<sup>th</sup> Place – Loser versus Loser

For 9<sup>th</sup> Place – Winner versus Winner

## **9. Protests**

9.1. The Sport schools/Clubs coach or representative must notify the game's head referee of the protest after the game.

9.2. The submission of the protest will be noted in the score sheet within 15 minutes of the game's conclusion, in accordance with International Volleyball rules.

9.3. Protests will be reviewed by the competition's head referee, head secretary and competition coordinator.

## **10. Awards**

10.1. The top three teams receive a trophy and a diploma.

10.2. Top three teams' players receive medals. (12 players, 3 team officials).

10.3. The six best players receive a memento trophy.

10.4. All other teams receive a diploma showing their place in the competition.
